### PLENARY INDULGENCE FOR THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE APPARITIONS AT FATIMA

In observance of this year's 100th Anniversary of the apparitions of Our Lady at Fatima, Pope Francis has granted a Plenary Indulgence to the faithful who make a pilgrimage to the shrine in Fatima, Portugal. For those who are unable to make that pilgrimage, the indulgence is extended also to those who

*“visit with devotion an image of Our Lady of Fatima solemnly displayed for public veneration”  
in any church, oratory, or chapel on the 100th Anniversary of any of the apparitions,  
i.e., on May 13, June 13, July 13, Aug. 13, Sept. 13, or Oct. 13 of this year, 2017.*

In addition to the usual requirements for obtaining a Plenary Indulgence (i.e., true repentance from sins, reception of sacramental absolution in Confession, reception of Holy Communion, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father), it is also necessary that the visit on any of the aforementioned days include participation in a Celebration or Prayer in Honor of Our Lady, recitation of the Lord's Prayer, the Creed, and a prayer to Our Lady of Fatima.



Before the Blessed Mother appeared to the children, the Angel of Peace taught the three shepherd children this prayer:

***“O my God, I believe, I adore, I hope and I love you. I beg pardon for all who do not believe, do not adore, do not hope and do not love You.”***

The three children would pray this simple prayer of adoration and intercession for hours and hours each day. It helped them to progress rapidly in virtue and holiness.

If God sent an Angel from heaven to give us this prayer, it must be quite important and powerful.

***Let us memorize it and pray it often during the day.***

**MESSAGE OF FATIMA**  
**Penance, Prayer and Devotion to my Immaculate Heart**

**THE MOST POWERFUL WEAPON ON EARTH—  
IS THE ROSARY**

“When you say your Rosary, the angels rejoice, the Blessed Trinity delights in it. My Son finds joy in it, too, and I myself am happier than you can imagine. After the Holy Sacrifice of the Mass, there is nothing in the Church that I love as much as the Holy Rosary.” *(Our Lady to Blessed Alan De LaRoche)*

The Rosary is basically a Gospel Prayer, and for those who pray it properly, it is, as Sr. Lucia said, “a simple method of getting closer to God.” But to pray it properly requires that each decade be a reflection on some aspect of the Joyful, Sorrowful, Glorious or Luminous Mysteries of our redemption. Without that meditation, the Rosary would become monotonous repetition. In praying the Rosary we can well take Our Lady as a model, for as the Scriptures tell us, “Mary kept all these words, pondering them in her Heart.”
